Victims

Four Palestinian refugees died in Syria including a girl by sniper shot.

They are:

- *The Palestinian refugee "Hussein Taha" from the Yarmouk camp died due to an explosive barrel were dropped by the Syrian warplanes on Monday 6th of April which targeted his house in the Yarmouk camp.*
- *The girl "Zainab Daghistani," 12 years old resident of Al Orouba neighborhood died by a sniper shot.*
- *The refugee "Mohammed Obaid Qasim" died due to the lack of nutrition and medical care inside the Yarmouk camp.*
- *The Palestinian refugee "Ibrahem Abdulhafiez," "Abu Hamza" was recognized within the leaked pictures of torture victims in the Syrian prisons; he died due to torture at the branch "215" a Syrian security branch. It is mentioned that he is from Damr area in Damascus.*

Recent Updates

Aknaf brigades issued a statement about ISIS breaking into the Yarmouk camp revealed a scheme was sketched from several direction in order to end the Yarmouk camp and to wipe it from the Palestinian map. The



scheme was revealed withing the scenario of ISIS breaking into the camp which justifies a wide military operation to destruct the camp.

Aknaf brigades confirmed in its statement that it seeks since the beginning of preventing ISIS entry into the camp, the thing that provoked the brigades to hold an agreement with Al Nusra Front to neutralize the camp and to protect its residents. However, Al Nusra Front did not abide to the assigned conventions and the agreements between the armed brigades, the Civic Institutions, and the Palestinian Faction, since Al Nusra Front facilitated the entry of ISIS the thing theta besieged Aknaf Brigades on all sides. The statement revealed the names of the brogades and the Palestinian groups that supported ISIS and facilitated its entry.

Aknaf Brigades also noted that ending the Yarmouk camp scheme, began with assassinating activists and relief workers such as Abu Abed Areisha, Abu Ahmed Tirawih and most recently, "Yahya Al-Hourani," known as (Abu Suhaib Hourani).

In addition, it revealed in its statement that Alkarain group is the responsible of the assassination of the activist, "Abu Abed Areisha," while " Abu Ahmed Tirawih " was assassinated by the so-called" Abu Saleh Amer ", while" Yahya Al-Hourani "(Abu Suhaib) was assassinated by" Abu Khalid Aleldawi "the attendant of ISIS commander south of Damascus " Abu Sayah Tayara. "

The statement pointed out that these assassinations targeted the cadres and leaders of the Aknaf Brigades also in the camp.

At the end of the statement Aknaf confirmed that they will continue fighting on the border of the camp until they expellISIS.



Violent clashes broke out in the Yarmouk camp in the 7th day of ISIS breaking into the camp between Aknaf brigades alongside with the youth of the camp and ISIS members. The clashes concentrated at the axes of the Yarmouk high school for girls and Jalal Kaoush Street adjacent to Palestine Street as well as Al Orouba area near Yelda area. Meanwhile, heavy shelling targeted the old Martyrs Cemetery and the vicinity of Al Basil Hospital.

The number of victims since ISIS broke into the camp has reached to 20 victims, where the Palestinian refugee "Hussein Taha" from the Yarmouk camp died due to an explosive barrels that targeted his house on Monday 6th of April 2015, while the girl "Zainab Dagjistani," 12 years resident of Al Orouba neighborhood in the Yarmouk camp was also killed by a nipper shot.

The Palestinian refugee "Mohammed Obaid Qasim" died due to the lack of nutrition and medical care inside the Yarmouk camp raising the siege and starvation victims to 174 victims.

In terms of the relief aspect, Noor Association for Relief and Development and Jafra Foundation managed to enter four relief vehicles contain a number of food baskets through Babbila checkpoint - Sidi Miqdad, to Yalda area, where they will be distributed to the residents of the Yarmouk refugee camp who were displaced to the adjacent area of Yalda.



Zaytuna Center for Studies issued a report entitled "the Yarmouk Camp, Where to?" in which it addressed the recent developments in the Yarmouk refugee camp, and ISIS breaking into the camp, the report concluded with many possible scenarios in light of the developments in the Yarmouk refugee camp and the obvious military progress of ISIS groups.

In the meantime, the president of The Global Popular Committee for Support Gaza Dr. Essam Youssef called all international organizations and stakeholders in all their whereabouts to accelerate the move to save the Yarmouk refugee camp and its inhabitants.

Palestinian Doctors League in Europe warned of humanitarian, health, and environmental unprecedented crises in the Yarmouk refugee camp if hostilities did not stop. The members devoted all their potential, capabilities, expertise, staff, and doctors at the disposal of their own people in the Yarmouk refugee camp.

For his part, the popular youth mobilization in the occupied city of Jerusalem clarified in a statement that the targeting of the Yarmouk camp



is to target the right of return and the killing of the Palestinian refugees only serves the Zionist project and his aides.

In the Southern of Syria, the Syria Warplanes targeted Der'aa camp for Palestinian Refugees after bombing some areas in Der'aa with explosive barrels that didn't led to casualties amongst the civilians. Der'aa camp was exposed to frequent clashes and bombing since the beginning of the ongoing war in Syria that caused, according to unofficial statistics, damages for about 70% of its buildings. The destruction led to that hundreds of Palestinian families were forced to leave to the neighboring towns, where the remaining people are suffering of severe humanitarian crises such as living and health crises. Water cut on the camp for 357 days respectively is considered as amongst the most prominent problems that forced the residents to drink from the polluted water though the continuous warnings of the spread of diseases.

Release

The Syrian Security released three of refugees from Al Aedin Camp in Homs; they are Moahmmmed Omar Al Shably and the student Moath Marwan Zahrawi at the same day of arrest, where they also released Mohammed Ahmed Khelfa in the second day of his arrest.

Lebanon

The Palestinian Camps in Lebanon such as Nahr Al Bared, Ein El Helwi and Burj Al Barajneh witnessed solidarity sit-ins with the besieged people



of Yarmouk camp who are exposed to violent airstrikes and land attacks from ISIS.

The Palestinians Doctors League in Europe in cooperation with Al Shefaa Medical Society in Beirut carried out the healthy nourishment project for the Palestinian refugees in Lebanon and the displaced Palestinians of Syria in Lebanon.

Numbers and Statistics till 6/4/2015

- *At least 27933 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.*
- *The Yarmouk Camp: - Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 640 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 720 days, water was cut for 210 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 174 victims.*
- *80,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees escaped from Syria to the neighboring towns, including 10,687 refugees in Jordan, 51,300 in*

Lebanon and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to UNRWA statistics till February 2015.

- ***Al Husayneyya Camp:*** - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for **541** days respectively.
- ***Al Sbeina Camp:*** - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for **511** days respectively.
- ***Handarat Camp:*** - Residents have left the camp for **713** days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- ***Dara'a Camp:*** - It is now almost **356** days without water and **70%** of its buildings were demolished.
- ***Jermana, AL Saieda Zainab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma:*** - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.
- ***Khan Al Sheih Camp:*** - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.
