

Introduction

More than four years, and the war in Syria is still going on, with the loss of more Palestinian refugee victims, where the AGPS statistics and documentation team documented most of the Palestinian Syrian victims regardless of their political affiliation or concerns.

The Group has managed to document (3089) Palestinian victims who were killed directly due to Bombing, clashes, torture in detention centers, explosions, siege, and others were killed indirectly due to sank while trying to reach Europe by what has become known as "Boats of Death".

(1704) victims were scattered on all Palestinian refugee camps in Syria, such as Deraa in the north, Khan Dannon, Khan Al Shieh, Al Sayeda Zainab, Yarmouk, Jaramana, Sbeina, Husseneia, Al Aedein in Homs and Hama, AL Raml, Handarat and Al Nairab in the south, in addition to (1315) victims who died outside their camps in various Syrian cities, and (70) victims who died outside Syria.

The AGPS documented (427) victims who were tortured to death in the prisons of the Syrian regime.

It should be noted that this report concerns of documenting the statistics of the Palestinian refugee victims in Syria since the beginning of the events until the end of September 2015, with no concern about identifying the actual doer.



(2675) Males and (414) Females



Statistics According to the country

(70) Palestinian refugees died outside Syria, including (15) refugees in Egypt, (6) refugees in Malta, (8) refugees in Greece, (12) refugees in Lebanon, (8) refugees in Turkey, (3) refugees in Palestine, (3) refugees in Italy, (10) refugees in Libya, (1) refugee in Sweden, (1) refugee in Cyprus, (1) refugee in Macedonia, and (2) refugee in Germany.




Statistics according to the Syrian Governorates:

Based on statistics that were documented by the AGPS, (3019) Palestinian victims died in Syria till the end of September 2015.

(1140) refugees died in Damascus, (699) refugees died in Damascus suburb, (512) refugees died in border and different unknown areas; such as places of torture to death in the Syrian prisons, (321) refugees died in Deraa, (175) refugees died Aleppo, (69) refugees died in Homs, (31) refugees died in Hama, (18) refugees died in Latakia, (31) refugees died in Qunaitra, (23) refugees from different Palestinian camps in Aleppo; most of them died in Idleb while performing the PLA obligatory military services, as they were executed in a horrible massacre on 11/7/2012, in addition to (16) refugees died in Swaidaa.

Distribution of Palestinian Victims according to the Palestinian Camps and Compounds in Syria:

(1704) Palestinian refugees died till the end of September 2015; some of them were directly targeted inside their camps and compounds in Syria, as (1018) refugees died in the Yarmouk camp in Damascus, (198) refugees died in Deraa south of Syria, (92) refugees died in Khan Al Sheih camp in Damascus suburb, (94) refugees died in Husseneia, and (51) refugees died in Al Nairab camp in Aleppo.

The AGPS documented (50) refugees died in Sbeina camp in Damascus suburb, (22) refugees died in Al Aedein camp in Homs, (40) refugees died in Handarat Camp in Aleppo, (39) refugees died in Sayeda Zainab camp, (25) refugees died in Jaramana camp in Damascus suburb, (31) refugees died in Muzaireib camp in Deraa, (20) refugees died in AL Aedein camp in Hama, (7) refugees died in Al Raml camp in Latakia, (10) refugees died in Khan Dannon Camp in Damascus suburb, (6) refugees died in Diabiyya compound in Damascus suburb, and (1) refugees died in Rokn Al Dein compound in Damascus suburb.



Distribution of Palestinian Victims according to the Reasons of Death:

(3089) Palestinian refugees died in Syria till the end of 2015 for various reasons; bombing caused the death of (1056) refugees, including (33) refugees died due to the chemical bombing that targeted their areas.

Meanwhile, (691) refugees died during clashes, (427) refugees died due to torture in the prisons of the Syrian regime, (283) refugees died by sniper shot, (184) refugees died due to the strict siege imposed on the Yarmouk camp, (84) refugees were field executed, (80) refugees died due to explosions, (77) refugees died and were documented as unknown according to their families, (43) refugees were killed after being kidnapped, (39) refugees sank during immigration, (27) refugees died by Israeli fire, and (98) refugees died due to various reasons; such as white weapon, burning, buildings collapsing, assassinating, and suffocating.



Conclusion:

It is worth mentioning that the previous statistics were done by the documentation and statistics team of the Action Group for Palestinians of Syria, as the numbers are likely to increase because of the tense situation that preventing the documentation of all cases.

Many residents are reluctant to communicate with authorities about human rights for fear of harassment, as well as the difficulty of moving and communications also preventing, in many cases, without collecting adequate information about the victims.

In addition, a large number of missing people who were lost during the disaster of sinking "boats of death" in the Mediterranean early on October 2013, where hundreds of remains Palestinian Syrian refugees who were on board are missing.

On the other hand, it should be noted that most reasons that led to the death of (3089) Palestinian victims are still exist, since many Palestinian refugee camps are still exposed to Shelling between now and then in addition to the continued siege imposed on the Yarmouk camp.

The AGPS confirms that this report concerns about documenting the statistics of Palestinian refugee victims in Syria since the beginning of events till the end of September 2015, with no concern about identifying the actual doer.
